He has acted as Contract Administrator on traditional contracts and has worked with other forms of procurement, such as Design & Build and Local Government Frameworks, some of which were based on a Partnering approach.

In addition to architectural work, Andrew was involved in aspects of practice management for example fee and resource management. This included the implementation of a new practice-wide project accounting system.
